Thank you for your recent interest in our preschool program. 
We offer a half day preschool from 9 am – 1 pm with the options of Early Morning Drop Off (8am - 9am) and Afternoon Enrichment (1pm-3pm) to meet the needs of all families. Our classrooms are full of developmentally appropriate learning, laughing and love! Please call to schedule your tour today.

**Open Enrollment begins on Tuesday, February 15<sup>th</sup>.** To reserve your child's space, we will need the registration card completed with the program selection on the reverse-side along with the registration fee (\$85 for returning families, \$100 for new families). VPK students will use their voucher in lieu of a registration fee.

VPK vouchers are available at two convenient "Round-Ups" here at CPP on Friday, March 11 from 10 am – 12 pm and again Saturday, March 12 from 9 am – 1 pm. After these dates, vouchers will be available at the Sanford VPK Office. Please contact Marsha Campbell at 321-832-6407 to set an appointment or to help you locate a Round-Up in your area. VPK vouchers must be turned in as your registration fee. Each family will need to bring proof of your child's age (ex. birth certificate or passport) and proof of your residency (ex. Driver's license with accurate address, electric bill, or mortgage/lease). Children's social security cards or number would be helpful but not necessary.
